

"Lift up your gates you rulers; and be lifted up you eternal gates, and the king of glory will enter. Who is this King of Glory? The Lord mighty and powerful, the Lord powerful in war. Lift up your gates you rulers; and be lifted up you eternal gates, and the King of Glory will enter. Who is this King of Glory? The Lord of powers, he is the King of Glory." Psalm 24:7-10

In a few short weeks we will be celebrating the great feast of our Lord's Ascension, a wondrous event of great significance; an event which we Orthodox Christians faithfully declare each time we recite the Creed, "...and He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father, and He will come again to judge the living and the dead, His reign shall have no end," an event of promise and of hope.

During our Lord's incarnate ministry the truth of His person was revealed to His Holy Disciples in various and diverse manners, both in shadow and in brightness, as He lovingly sought to raise their minds aloft to a full understanding of his identity and His divine purpose. But this process of growth was slow, for as the Disciples were mere men, they often became afraid and confused, and lapsed into doubt. Thus, as the events of our Lord's passion, crucifixion and death upon the Cross unfolded before the Holy Disciples, they became exceedingly sorrowful not understanding how one so powerful could be brought so low, to be betrayed, crucified upon a Cross, die and be buried in a tomb, for they had hoped that He would restore the earthly Kingdom of Israel. It would not be until our Lord's Ascension, and the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, that their minds would be fully opened to the deep truths of God's purpose.

Therefore, following His resurrection from the dead, and fully aware of the weakness of their resolve, our Lord sought to uplift the minds of His Holy Disciples on to higher things, manifesting Himself to them in ways new and marvelous; no longer abiding with them as a man, but appearing and disappearing before them in His incorruptible resurrected and glorified body, demonstrating to them His power over nature itself. In this way, He gave them greater courage, and their faith increased, preparing them for the coming of the Comforter, the Spirit of Truth. But even as our Lord was about to ascend into the heavens, the Disciples still hoped for a restoration of the earthly Kingdom of Israel. But this desire, which they held in their hearts, was not the intended will of God the Father, who sought not to recreate earthly Kingdoms, but to heal and reestablish the broken relationship between God and man. This He made possible by means of His incarnation through which He united His divine nature with the fallen nature of mankind, and thereby gave opportunity for the translation of that which was of the earth, into the heavenly places, to the very throne of the Living God. He finally accomplished this when He ascended from them, thereby demonstrating the full power and purpose of His resurrection from the dead. My beloved, let us be joyful in heart and soul, for we are the beneficiaries of our Lord's mercy, having brought us to the very heights of heaven, and placed us on a throne of glory before the face of God. Indeed, the King of Glory has entered in, the gates have been opened, our Lord has ascended, and we can but marvel at so great a God as our God, who works such wonders for mankind, His beloved.

Praying that the joy of His glorious Ascension will truly fill your hearts with heavenly bliss and divine peace, I Remain,


